Is he/she eligible to appear in FMGE Screening Examination as per MCI Guidelines 2002.</p> | <p>Your attention is invited to Clause 2(6) and 4(1) of the Screening Test Regulations, 2002 which reads as under:-</p> <p>"2(6) Primary Medical qualification" means a medical qualification awarded by any medical institution outside India which is a recognized qualification for enrolment as medical practitioner in the country in which the institution awarding the said qualification is situated and which is equivalent to MBBS in India;"</p> <p>"4. Eligibility Criteria: No person shall be allowed to appear in the screening test unless:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">2. he/she is a citizen of India or has been granted Overseas citizenship of India and possess any primary medical qualification, which is confirmed by the Indian Embassy concerned, to be a recognized qualification for enrolment as medical practitioner in the country in which the institution awarding the said qualification is situated." |
